## OBJECTIVES OF THE STUDY VISIT

The mobility initiative “Digital Education Practices in Tuscany” aims to provide participants with the opportunity to explore, observe, and compare innovative digital education practices within different institutional and organisational contexts in the Tuscan region.

The specific objectives of the initiative are to enable participants to:

- Gain a deeper understanding of how digital technologies are integrated into education, training, and professional environments in Tuscany
- Observe how ICT tools, artificial intelligence, and digital methodologies are applied in both academic and vocational contexts
- Acquire knowledge of innovative teaching approaches and organisational models in schools, universities, and private sector organisations
- Experience real-life practices in digital education through meetings, presentations, and lesson or laboratory observations
- Exchange best practices with professionals working in education, higher education, and the ICT and digital innovation sectors
- Strengthen professional networks and explore opportunities for future European cooperation in the field of digital education

## TARGET GROUPS

The mobility initiative is addressed to school teachers and education professionals interested in digital innovation and the use of ICT in teaching and learning processes.

## EXPECTED RESULTS

Participants will have the opportunity to become familiar with innovative approaches, strategies, and tools for integrating digital technologies into education and training systems in Tuscany.

In addition, the programme will allow participants to engage directly with university lecturers, school leaders, ICT teachers, and professionals from the digital and training sectors, fostering the exchange of experiences, challenges, and best practices.

The study visit will also contribute to the development of new professional contacts and potential partnerships for future European cooperation projects in the field of digital education.

## ROLE OF PIXEL AS HOST ORGANIZATION

Pixel is responsible for implementing the programme, liaising with local organisations, preparing the study visits, providing tutoring during the visits, offering language support, and ensuring overall monitoring and supervision. A representative from Pixel will accompany the group during each visit to the host organisations, offering practical assistance in reaching the institutions, supporting participants throughout the visit, facilitating introductions, moderating the sessions, and providing linguistic support. At the end of the mobility period, each participant is asked to complete an evaluation form covering all aspects of their experience in Italy. Pixel collects these forms and uses them to produce an evaluation report on the overall experience. The results are then used to plan future mobility initiatives, building on the strengths identified and addressing any weaknesses.
