OBJECTIVES OF THE STUDY VISIT

The Study Visit entitled “Exchange of Good Practices to deal with Racism and Discrimination within the School” aims to provide participants with:

- Inter-cultural Competences
This encompasses understanding cultural nuances, developing empathy towards different cultures, and effectively communicating in a multicultural environment.
- Language Skills
Improvement of language skills relevant to the host country and English.
- Understanding Racism and Discrimination
Knowledge of cultural, social, and economic factors leading to racism and discrimination.
- Inclusive Education Strategies
Skills in creating safe and inclusive educational environments.

EXPECTED RESULTS

The participants in the “Primary School Education in Italy” Study Visit will have the opportunity to: acquire a better understanding of the Italian and Tuscan Education and Training system; acquire knowledge about the current policies and strategies for tackling racism and discrimination in secondary education; acquire information about how the Italian Education and Training systems are organized and managed in Italy and in Tuscany in particular; share best practices in reducing racism and discrimination in secondary vocational education; develop new contacts and explore opportunities of cooperation with public and private institutions operating in the Educational and Training system in Tuscany.

ROLE OF PIXEL AS HOST ORGANIZATION

Pixel organizes the Study Visit at local level.

Pixel is in charge of the implementation of the programme, of the liaising with local bodies, of the preparation of the visits, of the tutoring during the visits, of the language assistance, of the monitoring and supervision, etc.

A representative of Pixel will be accompanying the group during each visit to the hosting institutions, providing practical assistance in reaching the institutions to be visited, giving assistance during the visit, making all the necessary reciprocal introductions, moderating the visit and providing linguistic support.
